### A Teenage Magazine

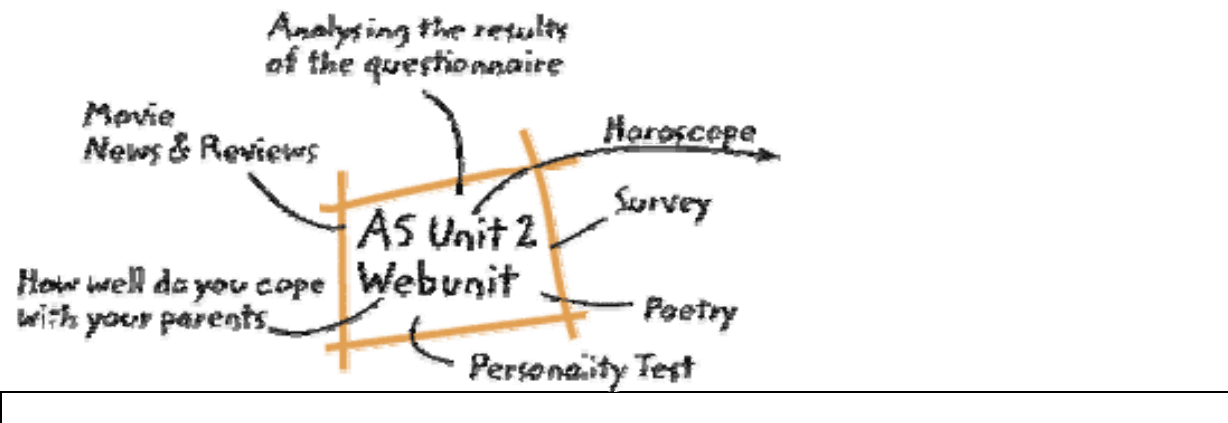
#### Task 1: Finding a Title for Your Teenage Magazine

First, your class should find a title for the youth magazine. Give reasons for your choice and discuss them in class. Have a vote on the best title.

#### Task 2: Editorial Tasks

You are the editorial staff of the youth magazine. Here is a list of topics you have to work on. So get together in groups of three and decide on a topic you would like to deal with.

Then decide who is going to do which topic in your class. You will find the different tasks listed on worksheet number 2.



#### Task 3: Getting to Know Yourself

Before you start working on your different tasks, fill in the personality questionnaire from the website given in the web unit. The results are needed for Task 4: *Analysing the Results*. Then print it out (**without your name**) and give it to the *Analysing the Questionnaire*-team.

The personality test and the survey in your class should be part of your youth magazine, of course.

#### Task 4: Analysing the Results of the Questionnaire

Once you are given all the questionnaires by your classmates, your task is to analyse the questionnaires and write a report about your findings. The **Unit task** in your textbook **A5, Unit 2, p.19** will give you some help on how to do your work.



### Task 5: Horoscopes

A youth magazine without horoscopes wouldn't be worth reading! And so our youth magazine offers a section with horoscopes as well:

### Task 6: Personality Test

This test is an important part of your youth magazine.

1. First do the test yourself and then try to develop your own test. (You can use some of the items from the test.)
2. A certain number of points should be given for each answer.
3. Then you should write down what kind of personality fits to each score. You can use the results from the internet site, or you can invent your own profile. (the examples of the next two sites will help you).

### Task 7: Poetry

Some teenagers are very skilled in writing wonderful poems and it goes without saying that a poetry section in your magazine is a 'must'. You can invent a poem (you may choose the topic yourself) and publish it in your magazine. But probably your poems are so good that you want to publish them in the following American youth magazine.

Before you write your own poems you can read some poems from [teenmag.com](http://teenmag.com). And then you can type in your new poem. (You might want to write your poem with *Word* and the copy it into the site just mentioned.)

### Task 8: How Well Do You Cope with Your Parents?

Another important topic in youth magazines is the relationship between parents and their children. You will find a quiz on this topic:

1. Before you have a look at the quiz, think of some problems between parents and children that the readers of your youth magazine might share with you.
2. Now answer the questions yourself and then develop a quiz for your magazine. Each answer should be given a certain number of points and then the scores should lead to a result (the results given on the next site will help you).
