1 Introducing Meadowhall

- Meadowhall is an area of 20,000 acres within Sheffield's Lower Don Valley.
- Meadowhall has a shopping area of 1.3 million square metres.

2 History and construction

- Till February 1984 there was a school in the place where Meadowhall now stands.
- Work on the Meadowhall building started in January 1988. It took 35 months to build Meadowhall and it opened in September 1990.
- There are 15,000 flowers in and around Meadowhall.
- Meadowhall opened late.

3 Location and access

- Meadowhall is 3 miles south west of Sheffield City Center.
- There are more than 12,000 parking spaces. The parking spaces cost £2.50 per hour.
