1. Bunratty Castle and Folk Park

- a. Bunratty Castle was built in the 13th century.

2. King John's Castle

- a. The castle was built between 1210 and 1250.
- b. From the castle you have a great view of Dublin city.

3. Craggaunowen - the living past

- a. In Craggaunowen you can see what it was like to live in Celtic England.
- b. One attraction is the "Brendan Boat", in which the explorer Tim Severin sailed from Ireland to Africa.
- c. You can also see how people farmed, hunted and travelled.
- d. Craggaunowen is open until 9 o'clock in the evening.

4. Tavern at the castle

- a. It's the only 17th-century tavern in Limerick.
- b. Tavern at the Castle is a typical Irish pub on three levels.
- c. Upstairs there is a room in which 200 people can have dinner together.
- d. In the pub you can see traditional and modern Irish paintings.

5. Croom Mills

- a. Croom Mills tells the story of an Irish town mill.
- b. You can also learn about the family who bought it and the people who lived around the mill.

6. St. Mary's Cathedral

- a. The cathedral is open daily for services.
- b. The cathedral was founded by Donal Mor O'Brien, who died in 1872.
