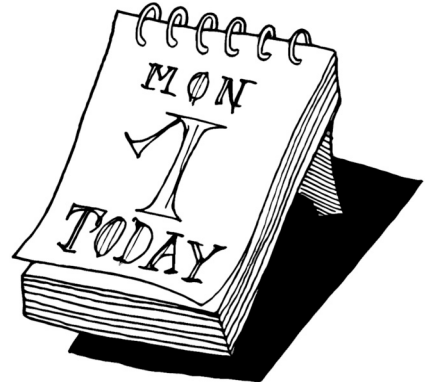


Time and date
